

THE INTERREG POLAND-RUSSIA PROGRAMME 2021-2027 POLICY OBJECTIVES

PO 2: A greener, low-carbon Europe (including energy transition, the circular economy, climate adaptation and risk management)

- Promoting access to water and sustainable water management (PRIORITY: ENVIRONMENT)
- Promoting the transition to a circular (PRIORITY: ENVIRONMENT)
- Enhancing nature protection, biodiversity (and green infrastructure in particular in the urban environment), and reducing all forms of pollution (PRIORITY: ENVIRONMENT)

PO 4: A more social Europe (the European Pillar of Social Rights)

- Ensuring equal access to health care and fostering resilience of health systems, including primary care and promoting the transition from institutional to family- and community-based care (PRIORITY: HEALTH AND LONG-TERM CARE)
- Enhancing the role of culture and sustainable tourism in economic development, social inclusion and social innovation (PRIORITY: TOURISM)


ISO 1: A better cooperation governance

- Build up mutual trust, in particular by encouraging people-to-people actions (PRIORITY: COOPERATION)





THE INTERREG POLAND-RUSSIA PROGRAMME 2021-2027 TYPE OF PROJECTS







LARGE INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS

•THEMATIC SCOPE: Environment, Health and long-term care, Tourism

•SUBMISSION: non-competitive direct award

•PROJECT BUDGET: co-financing up to 6 000 000 EUR

•DURATION: up to 36 months

•READINESS: project shall be ready for implementation

INFRASTRUCTURE: min. 2 500 000 EUR on acquisition, construction or modernisation of infrastructure





REGULAR PROJECTS

•THEMATIC SCOPE: Environment, Health and long-term care, Tourism, Cooperation

•SUBMISSION: open call for proposals

•PROJECT BUDGET: co-financing from 100 000 EUR to 2 500 000 EUR

•DURATION: up to 24 months

•READINESS: project shall be ready for implementation

INFRASTRUCTURE: max. 2 500 000 EUR on acquisition, construction or modernisation of infrastructure





MICRO PROJECTS

•THEMATIC SCOPE: Environment, Health and long-term care, Tourism, Cooperation

•SUBMISSION: open call for proposals

•PROJECT BUDGET: 10 000 EUR to 100 000 EUR

•DURATION: up to 12 months

•INFRASTRUCTURE: no acquisition, construction or modernisation of infrastructure





THE INTERREG POLAND-RUSSIA PROGRAMME 2021–2027 EXAMPLES OF BENEFICIARIES

- •regional and local authorities, bodies providing public services commissioned by these authorities, other legal entities with the participation of these authorities or acting on their behalf;
 - •central bodies, on behalf of regional and local representations responsible for carrying out public tasks at the regional/local level;
 - •regional and local representations of central government, responsible for carrying out public tasks at the regional/local level;
 - •state organisations/institutions;
 - •public institutions responsible for environment protection management of nature protection areas, nature parks and local forestry directorates;
 - •public educational and research institutions (public schools, public universities, etc.);
- •non-governmental organisations and non-profit organisations, such as Euroregions, business support organisations, chambers of commerce, organisations promoting tourism, research institutions, associations, foundations, parishes, etc.
