
- A. Programme based on thematic priorities
- B. Interreg Specific Objective with thematic focus
- C. Interreg Specific Objective with open thematic scope

## A. based on thematic priorities



- Scope defined by a selection of Policy Objectives (PO) and Specific Objectives (SO)
- Each PO addressed in a separate Priority
- Each selected SO addressed in a separate objective under corresponding priority
- Can be chosen from POs 1 to 4

#### Programme structure scenario A




#### **B. ISO** with thematic focus



- Interreg Specific Objective (ISO) as single objective
- Thematic scope is defined in the CP by a 'selection' of Policy & Specific Objectives
- All themes can be covered in one Priority
- Policy Objectives 1 to 5 can be considered

#### Programme structure scenario B




## C. ISO with open thematic scope



- Interreg Specific Objective (ISO) as single objective
- Thematic scope
  - ✓ broadly defined by EU strategies and cohesion policy
  - ✓ further specified by identifying policy challenges of shared relevance
- The focus can be fine-tuned during programme implementation (e.g. per call for proposals)
